On-The-Job Training (OJT)

The OJT program enables employers to hire and train new employees while being reimbursed a percentage of the new employee's wages during the training period.

Employer Benefits:

- Reducing the cost of hiring and training
- Providing pre-screened applicants for a position the employer decides who to hire
- Reimbursing the employer for a percentage of the wages during the pre-agreed training period. Reimbursement rate is based on the size of the business
